ALABAMA.

1867.

DESCRIPTION.

In the centre of a shield, covering about two-thirds of the stamp, is an ornamental upright oval leaning slightly toward the right, and showing the coat of arms of Alabama, viz.: an open scroll placed against a tree. Above the oval in the upper corners of the shield is the numeral representing the value of the stamp, and between them in a curved line the word "dollar" or "dollars" in open letters. Above the shield the words "State of Alabama" in colored and the value in white Roman letters. In the *one* dollar, above all this there is, still a small ornamental upright oval with the numeral of value on solid ground. The upper and greater part of the stamp is enclosed by an ornamental frame, the lower by a faint line. In the "Two Dollars" there is a colored shading between this line and the shield.

CALIFORNIA.

California Revenues may be collected in two ways:

1st. Without regard to surcharge or paper.

2nd. With regard to both surcharge and paper.

The latter way is by far the most satisfactory, although it will prove a rather expensive luxury. The postage stamps of many countries are collected according to the color and size of the surcharge, why should the Revenues not be?

The surcharges found on California Revenues represent the initials of the several controllers, excepting one, during whose terms of office the tax was imposed. It is probable that the stamps were thus officially countersigned merely to give an additional proof of their genuineness. At all events none of these were sold to the public without such surcharge. In such condition they are what we call "unused."

The controllers whose initials have thus far been found are seven in number:

George W. Whitman, 1856-58—G. W. W. in two types in red, blue and black.

A. R. Meloney, 1858-59—A. R. M. (3 types) in black and blue.

S. H. Brooks, 1859-1861—S. H. B. in blue.

G. R. Warren, 1862-1863—G. R. W. (2 types) in blue.

George Oulton, 1863-67—G. O. (2 types) in blue.

Robert Watt, 1867-71—R. W. in blue and black.
James J. Green, 1871-75—J. J. G. in black.

It does not necessarily follow that stamps surcharged by the earlier controllers were used during their term of office only; remainders on hand were sold and used considerably later than the surcharge might lead one to suppose.

BILL OF LADING.

1857-1861.

The dimensions, *i. e.*, the length and breadth only of the design are given in the measurement of the stamp.

DESCRIPTION.

Large circular stamp, 33x33 mm. In the centre a solid concave-cornered oblong containing the value of the stamp and the amount for which it is used. Above the label in a curved line the words "Bill of Lading" in solid capitals, having the same colors as the stamp. Below the label the words "First," "Second," "Third" or "Fourth". All this surrounded by a solid circular band with a white lined border, within which, above, the word "California," below, "State Tax."

The stamps are cut from the sheet, as a rule, carelessly, and in various ways, *i. e.*, square, octagonally, cut to shape, in saw-tooth perforation, &c., apparently to suit each party.

Varieties of paper.

1. Thin bluish wove paper.
2. Thin white wove paper.

The color of the stamp is carmine, with shades bordering on vermilion, red, or rose. Paper No. 1. Thin bluish wove, on which the following surcharges are found:

- I. G. W. W. in blue, two types, differing slightly. The body of the "G" in the one is wider than in the other.
- II. { A. R. M. (a) in blue and black.
A. R. M. (b) " "
- III. S. H. B. in blue and black.

With surcharge G. W. W. in blue (no circle around), bluish paper.

FIRST ISSUE.—Blue on white. Solid letters.

DESCRIPTION.

Circular stamp 26x26mm. In the centre of the stamp a solid oblong with concave corners containing value of stamp and the amount for which it is used. Above the label in curved line the word "Exchange" in *solid* capitals having the same color as the stamp. Below the label the words: "First," "Second" and "Third," the whole surrounded by a white-lined border, within which, above, the word "California," below, the words "State Tax." The stamps are cut from the sheet, as a rule, carelessly and in various ways, *i.e.*: square, octagonally, cut to shape, circularly punched and in saw-tooth perforation, evidently to suit the one using them.

KINDS OF PAPER.

1. White wove paper.
2. Vertically laid bluish paper.

There have been sold at auction of this issue, some stamps on vertically laid *white* paper, which I examined very closely, and consider to be stamps on vertically laid *bluish* paper which have lost their color in some way or other.

The color of the stamp is blue with shades.

The only surcharge is G. W. W. in red, blue and black, without circle around.

STATE REVENUES 1862-72?

Large white ornamental figure of value in the centre of every stamp except in the \$1.00 and \$2.00 in which the figure of value is of the same color as the stamp. Around this value an upright oval, above which, in white curved ribands, the word "California," and below "State Revenue." On the sides of the oval two smaller white ribands, containing in Roman Capitals the value printed in the same color as the stamp. The central values in the oval are printed in monogram in all values above 80c.

The background of the stamp is different in most values. On stamps where the margin is sufficiently wide, in most cases, a faint line having the same color as the stamp will be found. The size of the stamp, irrespective of this line, is 20x23mm. The paper on all is white wove, varying in thickness, but not so materially as to make a classification necessary in that respect.

I have also found 2 specimens of the \$4.00 green on white paper with red lines across the upper stamp. They were both unused.

The surcharges on these stamps thus far found are:

- G. O. second type in blue only;
- R. W. in blue and black
- J. J. G. in black only

R. W. are the initials of controller Robert Watt, in office from Dec. 7th, 1867, to Dec. 2nd, 1871.

J. J. G. are the initials of controller James J. Green, in office from Dec. 2nd, 1871, to Dec. 4th, 1875.

Profile to right of Governor L. A. Wiltz in a horizontally lined ground, and enclosed in a frame the upper part of which is arched, the lower part has concave corners. Above the frame in a curved solid label the words "Louisiana" with rosettes on each side. Below the rosettes is the value in solid circles. Below the frame, in a curved label, the words "Law Stamps." In the centre and below these words a trefoil in which the coat of arms of the State of Louisiana. The letters are all white roman capitals, and the whole stamp has an ornamental frame. The values of \$1.00 and above are similar in design to the lower ones. Profile to left of Chief Justice Bermudez, of the Supreme Court of Louisiana, on a horizontal ground in a pointed arch. Below the point of the arch a trefoil containing the arms of the State of Louisiana. Above and running parallel with the lower arch a solid arch with the words "Louisiana Law Stamp." In the upper corners figures of value in white roman capitals. In the lower angles the figures of value are repeated. The frame enclosing the portrait is ornamental.

NEVADA, 1865-73.

In the centre of the 2 cents is a large five pointed single or double star on a rayed ground. If single the star is white and slightly shaded if double, the lower star is solid having the color of the stamp. In the center of the star is the number "2". Above the star a riband containing the word "NEVADA," below the star another curved riband with STATE REVENUE." At the sides of star two smaller ribands containing value in Roman capitals of the same color as the stamp.

In the four angles the figure "2" is repeated. In the other values the star is substituted by large white numbers except on the \$1.00 when the figure of value is of the same color of the stamp. The 25c is the only one having no ribands with the value at sides. The background of the stamps is different in most values. There is a faint line having the same color of stamp to be found on specimens with sufficiently large margin.

The size of the stamp irrespective of this line is 20x28 mm. There are two very distinct varieties of paper.

Paper No. 1. very thin white wove unperforated.

Paper No. 11. very thick " "

Although I have found intermediate thicknesses of paper particularly of the 5c and the 50c they are not sufficiently distinct to be classified separately. They are two roulettes, the *broad* one of one mm., from dent to dent, and the *fine* roulette about half that width. The rouletting is poorly executed.

INSURANCE.

Somewhat below the centre of the stamp is a *large* shield containing the coat of arms of the state. This large shield is surmounted by an eagle, on whose breast is a very small shield the lower extremity of which points either to the left or to the right of the centre of the larger shield beneath.

The stamps in which the lower extremity of the small shield points to the left of the middle of the large shield we will call type No. 1, which points to the right, type No. 2. Above the eagle mentioned before are either the value with denomination surmounted by an arched figure containing the word Oregon in colored Roman capitals or vice versa the word "Oregon" first with the value and the denomination above. The latter is the case with the 50 cents and 1 dollar stamps.

Immediately below the larger shield the value is repeated, and followed by the word "State Tax" in curved frame, inverse order again in the values of 50 cents and 1 dollar.

At the sides in colored oblongs the word "Insurance" is repeated. In the four corners are rosettes, except in the last mentioned values where the word "cents" and a star, or the word "one" are found.

The paper is wove and varies slightly in thickness but not sufficiently for cataloguing a separate issue.

There is a second set of those perforated 11½ of the second type, which differ somewhat from those mentioned above.

I have been told that the original plates of this type (whether of the first I do not know), were or still are in the possession of a Western man, and that he had the stamps reprinted. If so, he retouched the plates before using them, and hence the differences here mentioned. In the 10c of the reprints the space between the curved label containing the word "Oregon," and the oblong label on the right side containing the word "Insurance" differs materially from the original. In the 20c green the large shield is closer to the number 20 beneath it. In the 50c blue the two leg shaped ornaments jut out further. In the \$1.00 carmine the "s" of "Insurance" to the right is peculiar.

NOTE.—The reason that in the description of the "Oregon" Revenues I twice employed the word "used" unsevered pairs is, that I am still in doubt, whether *any unperforated stamps were ever used*. I have seen many whole sheets of unused ones, and I know where others can be had, but *never have I seen one used pair*.

UNITED STATES DOCUMENT STAMPS.

UNPERFORATED AND PART PERFORATED.

The cataloguing of Unperforated and Part Perforated Document Stamps has always been a most difficult matter to dealers as well as cataloguers. Official sources, as far as I know, give no sufficient clue as to different values and the exact dates they were thus issued. I have closely examined a large number of unperforated, part perforated, and perforated stamps, and the earliest date on unperforated documents I found, was May 1862, on part perforated documents it was Sept., 1862, on perforated documents it was Nov., 1862.

This shows conclusively that the three kinds were used during the same year.

The task I have undertaken to produce an as nearly perfect list of unperforated and part perforated stamps, as possible is by no means an easy one. Nor do I claim that what I give now to the public is faultless, but at all events it is as perfect as I can now furnish it.

When, many years ago, I began collecting *unperforated* and *part perforated* document stamps, I was anxious to procure the former with wide margins on all sides, and the latter with good margins at top and bottom, and though I found many values coming up to my standard, a great number were not satisfactory, because, although they had one or three margins as required, the second or fourth would not come up to the mark, the possibility existing that they might have been manufactured from perforated specimens with wide margins on two or three sides by trimming them.

When Mr. E. B. Sterling's excellent and exhaustive catalogue appeared, I perceived how little I had compared with what I ought to have in that line. Neither time nor money have I spared since to obtain good specimens of all catalogued, but found it impossible. I then made up my mind that a number of those listed were trimmed stamps and resolved to find out which were the ones. To partially achieve this I concluded to obtain by purchase or exchange all the values I could in unsevered pairs. I advertised for a long time and wrote letters to parties here and abroad, in fact I left nothing undone to further my aim, and the result is that I now own, as far as I know, a more complete collection of pairs than any other collector or dealer here or abroad. There is no doubt that the most satisfactory way to collect unperforated document stamps is to collect them in pairs, but it is also by far the most expensive way.

The list I am about to publish contains, with few exceptions, only those stamps of which others or myself have unsevered pairs, and although I have good specimens with wide margins of quite a number of other values, yet I am confident that they are trimmed stamps, in spite of the fact that I had to pay good prices for some of them. The few exceptions referred to above to which I give the benefit of the doubt, with an inclination toward considering them not issued as listed, are:

The 1c Playing Cards, 2c Playing Cards, blue, the 2c Propr. blue, the 25c Bond, the 40c brown, and the \$2.50 and \$10.00 Charter Party *unperforated*.

The 10c Bill of Lading, 25c Life Insurance, the \$1.00 Conveyance, the \$1.00 Inland Exchange, the \$1.00 Lease and the \$1.00 Mortgage *part perforated*.

FIRST ISSUE PERFORATED.

The perforated stamps appear on three different kinds of paper:

1. Old paper (the same as the unperforated).
2. Thick paper (of various thicknesses).
3. Silk paper (diminutive clippings, and few in number).

NOTE.—I have seen some stamps which seemed to be waterlined, but on further examination found they had been used on laid paper and received the impress from it. By wetting the stamp and pressing it with force while still damp, the lines partially disappeared. The stamps of light and bright color, and those on thick and silk paper were issued after those of darker hue and those on crisp and thin paper.

The stamps catalogued upon "surface colored paper" I consider to owe their existence to the negligence of the workmen in not wiping the plate properly, and therefore do not catalogue them.

To make a list of the stamps which are found with double perforations, would be an endless task. I consider them well worth collecting as oddities, and have a great many more than catalogued by Sterling. I dare say all values might be found so. The same may be said of those found with the engraver's imprint.

What are called "misstrikes" are also collected by some. They consist of stamps, the paper of which was creased when printed upon or when one stamp shows part of the adjoining stamp, or when perforations run through the stamp or are partially omitted, &c.

PROVISIONALS.

After the law was passed which compelled all firms manufacturing taxable articles (such as medicines, matches, perfumery, playing cards, etc.) to use government stamps, and before the special private dies designed by the manufacturers themselves were furnished to them, they used those of the regular national issue *provisionally*, surcharging them, however, with their initials, etc., for advertising purposes.

I would not advise a beginner to collect these stamps, but a well advanced collector of U. S. Revenues will certainly find them of sufficient interest to warrant their collection.

I will give here a complete list, as far as I know, of those U. S. document stamps only which bear on their face a surcharge of the initials of private firms. The surcharges are mostly in black. Those surcharged in other colors are fewer in number, hence scarce, and will be mentioned as they occur.

Outside of those surcharged medicine stamps mentioned in Mr. Sterling's comprehensive list, I have quite a number with dates not as yet catalogued, and I am quite sure that many others can be found elsewhere.

In the present list, instead of giving each date separately, I confine myself, where various dates surcharged in the same color and on the same paper exist, to merely give a description of different surcharges, color and paper, adding the words "various dates" only.

I also omit those surcharges which consist of lines or black marks which could be imitated by any child.

Wherever the color of the surcharge is not mentioned, it is always in black.
