This is my first attempt to send out circulars of American Stamps to foreign countries. Should the Stamp Collecting public abroad, place confidence in me and patronizeme, I shall publish another edition very soon. I assure stamp-collectors that such confidence will not be misplaced. All orders shall be filled by *return of post certain*. I will send such stamps only as are ordered, else *refund the money in Cash*. All stamps sold by me are *genuine* (no reprints, as U. S. Stamps have never been reprinted) and in perfect condition.

The next edition will contain price lists of rare U. S. Envelopes, *genuine* and *original* U. S. Locals, Confederate Locals, Canada, New Brunswick, New Foundland, Prince Edwards Island, South and Central American, Mexico, U. S. Revenues, (government, private and State) Canada, bill, &c., at wholesale and retail. The next edition will be published in January and will be sent to any part of the world on receipt of stamps, equivalent to 4 cents.

All orders must be accompanied by the *Cash*, including *postage* and cost of *registration*. In no case will stamps be sent except by registered mail.

Remittances should be made in P. O. Money order, Banker's Draft, coin or Paper Money. Postage Stamps of any denomination will be received from Great Britain, Austria and Hungary, low values from New Foundland, Barbadoes, 1/2d., Canada 1/2c., Bahamas, France, Serbia, Greece, Luxemburg, Heligoland, Argentine Republic, Austria (soldi issue), Portugal, Sweden unpaid and official.

Wanted to exchange, all kinds of foreign postage stamps, by the single, dozen, 100, 1,000 or 10,000.

All offers should be accompanied by the lowest price in exchange for U. S. Stamps, a stamp for return should accompany each letter, with full address of the sender every time.


