FOURTEENTH EDITION.

TO OUR READERS,

AND THE TRADE GENERALLY.

EVERY effort has been made, in preparing the Fourteenth Issue of this DIRECTORY, to have the information as correct as possible. We are pleased to be able to state that a larger amount of support has been accorded to us by the British Stamp Trade than was the case with former editions, and, in consequence, we believe that the present DIRECTORY is absolutely reliable, every name and address contained in it being correct at the end of October, 1902.

In proof of this a few statistics may not be out of place. The Thirteenth Edition of the DIRECTORY contained some 510 names and addresses of dealers, all of whom were circularised during September last, with an urgent appeal that "in any case" they would be good enough to give the matter their attention. The dealers were also asked that, if they did not desire their names inserted, they would advise us to that effect. About 160 of our circulars were returned to us duly filled in, whilst 39 were sent back by the Post Office marked "gone away," and 13 individuals requested us to withdraw their names. In addition to this, 77 new names are inserted, and several alterations have been made in addresses. It will thus be seen that everything reasonable has been done to secure the correctness of the DIRECTORY. We regret that a few of the forms were returned to us without any signature or other indication of the sender; and such were, of course, useless.

The Foreign and Colonial Appendix has not proved so successful as we anticipated; dealers abroad appear to think their names should be inserted free, but this, as we have already pointed out, is impracticable.

We are glad that a large and representative body of advertisers have again made use of the DIRECTORY for their announcements. The advertisements will be found by no means the least interesting portion of the book, and we would bespeak for them our readers' careful perusal.

Our thanks are returned to all who have helped in the compilation of this work.

THE illustrations in this new Victoria-Edition, although on a reduced scale, are very distinct and correct reproductions. They are printed on the margin of each page, leaving the spaces blank, in which the Postage Stamps are to be placed. Only one illustration appears of such Stamps, which, although of different values, are of the same design, and in these cases the former are printed underneath each impression, thus at once forming a complete Catalogue in conjunction with the Album.
