This Company is on the Protective Union principle, and has for its object the establishment of a uniform rate or tariff of prices for North American Colonial Postage Stamps. All the *responsible* dealers and collectors of New Brunswick are members of it, and have pledged themselves to the sustenance of its principles and rates. The members call attention to the fact that an established rate will be equally advantageous to all parties. They also state that they are driven to this measure by the growing scarcity of Colonials, and the utter impossibility of selling at the old rates at other than a loss. The tariff is made as low as possible and the Company hope will prove satisfactory. The members wish it to be *distinctly understood* that they do not deal as a Company but as *private individuals*, but that no departure from the Companys' tariff will be allowed by any of the members.
