Introductory Remarks.

DEAR SIR:—

The stamp market has, of late, been greatly disturbed owing to the general business depression prevailing all over the country. This has caused quite a number of collectors to dispose of their collections, who, after trying to sell one way or the other, and all endeavors proving fruitless, as a last refuge went to the auction room. There again, unfortunately, unscrupulous agents could be found, who would accept anything coming their way, regardless of consequences and unmindful of the true interests of the seller: thus, the auction business has been overdone; besides it is a well known fact that certain goods never will realize satisfactory prices at auction. Furthermore, the auction season being limited to a few months only, the rush must be detrimental. Again, quite naturally, the collector, after having spent considerable money and having become attached to his collection, dislikes to risk his stamps to the very uncertain chances of auction sales.

We have therefore devised another plan to reach philatelic buyers and the trade in behalf of those of our clients who wish to sell. We propose to issue from now on special catalogues, in which stamps, envelopes, etc., will be offered, described in the same manner as we have done in our auction catalogues. The owners will be required to price every article, which may be offered singly or in lots, or by bunching several articles together. We print and distribute the catalogues in sufficient quantities to secure sales, and our charges will only be 10% on actual sales. For lots remaining unsold we will charge a uniform rate of 25 cents for each lot advertised in the catalogues.

At a fixed and published date, which will be approximately one month after the date of mailing of the catalogues, the lots advertised will be withdrawn, and an accounting rendered to the owner with a cash settlement for all lots sold.

We feel confident to be able to always dispose of the majority of the lots advertised, provided the prices set by the owners comply with the conditions of the market as well as the discounts allowed by dealers, which is from 10 to 50% off catalogue quotations, according to the grade of rarity or condition of the stamp offered. If desired, we will undertake the pricing and submit our quotations to the owner for his approval; changes and modifications to suit his views can then be made.

What are the risks the owner assumes by availing himself of this opportunity? Absolutely none; he merely goes to the expense of advertising his goods with the fairest prospects of reaching a sale at his own price.

Our first catalogue on the plan outlined above is before you, and should you decide to choose any of the following catalogues to bring your goods to the notice of the buying philatelic public, we shall be pleased to serve you.

Statt einer Vorrede.

WERTHER HERR:—

Das Markengeschäft hat in letzterer Zeit manigfache Störungen erfahren, welche durch die ueber das ganze Land sich erstreckende Ungunst der Zeiten hervorgerufen worden ist. Eine grosse Anzahl von Sammlern ist dadurch veranlasst worden ihre Sammlungen auf den Markt zu bringen. Nachdem dieselben, ihren Zweck zu erreichen,

alle möglichen Mittel, versucht hatten, blieb ihnen in den meisten Fällen nur eine öffentliche Versteigerung als letzter Ausweg offen. Gewissenlose Leute indessen haben sich die zwingenden Umstände Anderer zu Nutzen gemacht & irgend etwas zur Versteigerung angenommen, was ihnen grade in den Weg gelaufen kam, ohne Rücksicht zu nehmen weder auf die üblen allgemeinen Folgen, noch auf die Interessen ihrer Auftraggeber. Dadurch ist das Auctionsgeschäft übertrieben worden; ferner aber ist es eine bekannte Sache, dass gewisse Marken niemals zufriedenstellende Preise auf Auctionen zu bringen vermögen, & weiterhin ist die Saison auf eine nur kurze Spanne Zeit beschränkt, so dass in der allgemeinen Eile zu verkaufen die Preise unbedingt leiden müssen. Dem Sammler indess, nachdem er nicht nur bedeutende Geldsummen aufgewendet, sondern auch sein Album liebgewonnen hat, wiederstrebt der Gedanke seine Schätze den ungewissen Zufällen einer Auction preiszugeben.

Im Interesse derjenigen unserer Kunden, welche zu verkaufen wünschen, haben wir uns deshalb entschlossen kauffähige Sammler & Händler auf eine andere Art & Weise zu erreichen. Wir werden von jetzt ab besondere Cataloge ("Special Catalogues") herausgeben, in welchen ganze Sammlungen & Seltenheiten zum Verkaufe angezeigt werden sollen. Wir werden die einzelnen Marken, Couverte, &c. genau beschreiben & deren Erhaltung und Beschaffenheit sorgfältig angeben, wie wir dies in unseren Auctions-Catalogen gethan haben, doch hat der Eigenthümer die Preise namhaft zu machen, die er für seine Waare zu erhalten wünscht. Wir drucken & versenden eine genügende Anzahl von Catalogen um hoffen zu dürfen Verkäufe herbeizuführen, & berechnen dafür 10% Commission vom Verkauften, während für Unverkauftes eine Gebühr von M. 1.—für jede Katalognummer in Ansatz kommt. An einem in den Katalogen angekündigtem Tage (ungefähr einen Monat nach Versendung derselben) werden die angezeigten Sachen vom Verkauf zurückgezogen & eine Cassa-Abrechnung mit den Eigenthümern herbeigeführt.

Wir sind davon überzeugt, dass es uns bei unserer ausgedehnten Kundschaft in beiden Hemisphären gelingen wird stets die Mehrzahl der angezeigten Nummern abzusetzen, vorausgesetzt, dass die Eigner ihre Preise im Einklang mit den Marktverhältnissen sowohl, als auch mit den Ermässigungen, die Händler bei Verkäufen gewähren, zu bringen verstehen. Dass ein Nachlass von 10 bis 50% von Katalogpreisen gewährt wird, je nach dem Seltenheitsgrade oder der Erhaltung der Marke ist wohl allgemein bekannt. Im Falle es gewünscht wird, sind wir bereit, ganze Sammlungen mit Verkaufspreisen zu versehen und unsere Markirungen sodann den Eigenthümern zu übermitteln, damit selbige ihren Ansichten & Wünschen entsprechende Abänderungen vornehmen können.
