

A COMPARITIVE LIST OF THE STAMPED PAPER OF THE UNITED STATES.

By A. F. HENKELS.

CIVIL WAR PERIOD.

In presenting this list of the stamped paper of the Civil War period I have taken the list published in 1888 by Mr. E. B. Sterling of Trenton, N. J., as the foundation of the present work. This list, for many years the standard pioneer work on this branch of United States fiscal philately, has become incomplete owing to the many discoveries since its date of publication. I have classified my list according to the system used by Mr. Sterling, and have used the descriptions given by him of all types listed in his 1888 catalogue, with such alterations and additions as were necessary. In numbering my list, the first column headed "H" are Henkels' numbers, the second column headed "S" are Sterling's numbers. My intention in making this list comparative is to facilitate collectors in re-arranging, who have previously arranged their collections according to Sterling's list. It is my wish to give Mr. Sterling full credit for all matter used from his catalogue in compiling my list, and also to extend my thanks to him for his courtesy in granting me his full permission.

It has been necessary to make one radical change in Mr. Sterling's list, in the case of "C" variety, 1, which I have placed in my list as "H" variety, 1. Upon ample proof and reasoning it has been decided that this type was not printed by the American Phototype Co. of New York but by Jos. R. Carpenter of Philadelphia, Pa., thereby necessitating its change from the New York series to the Philadelphia series. I have also omitted the listing of the Tom Thumb or vest pocket size checks from the order in which Mr. Sterling had them listed as "E" variety, 1a, and have made a separate list of them which will be found immediately after the list of stamped paper of the Spanish American war period.

Henkels "A" variety, 2; Sterling "A" variety, 2. Same design. Stamp on obverse and reverse, both sides alike. Size 22x25, used on receipts, etc.; on white paper.

Henkels "A" variety, 3; Sterling "A" variety, 3. Same design. Stamp re-

peated, showing value "2 Cents 2" fifty-seven or more times in one continuous string. Tape worm stamp or Specie clerk statement. Size 22x45 or more, on white paper.

Henkels "B" variety, 1; Sterling "B" variety, 1. Rectangular, printed in oval frame. Within centre, eagle at bay; oval band with "Internal Revenue"; above, "U. S."; at base of eagle, straight band, "Two Cents"; below, large "2". Fancy scroll work around stamp. Colored lozenge shaped tablet, 29x4 mm., inscribed "Good when issued for the payment of money." Also same design and stamp on reverse of receipt. Size 32x52 mm., white paper.

Henkels "B" variety, 9. Same as "B" variety, 8, with 10 centime stamp of France impressed in blue at right hand end of draft, the U. S. Revenue stamp is overprinted with the word "Check" in red, reading upwards, on surface colored paper.

Henkels "B" variety, 10; Sterling "B" variety, 6. Same design as "B" variety, 5, but with extra stamp on reverse of receipt. Without tablet. Size 32x42, on white paper.

Henkels "B" variety, 11; Sterling "B" variety, 7. Same design as "B" variety, 8, with card of American Phototype Co., conveying same in oblong frame. Size 58x43. At upper left of billhead. Fancy corners to frame, and printed in brown and purple.

Very large oblong stamp, Medallion head of Washington in centre, facing left; circular band inscribed "United States Internal Revenue"; at right and left, engraved bands supporting oval medal, bearing words "Two cents"; at top, "two, two (2) two, two"; at base, "2". Size 110x50, on white and various colored fancy papers.
