# A COMPARITIVE LIST OF THE STAMPED PAPER OF THE UNITED STATES. 

## CIVIL WAR PERIOD.

In presenting this list of the stamped paper of the Civil War period I have taken the list published in 1888 by Mr E. D. Sterling of Trenton, N.J., as the foundation of the present work. This list, for many years the standard pioneer work on this branch of United States fiscal philately, has become incomplete owing to the many discoveries since its date of publication. I have classified my list according to the system used by Mr. Sterling, and have used the descriptions given by him of all types listed in his 1888 catalogue, with such alterations and additions as were necessary. In numbering my list, the first column head ed "H" are Henkels" numbers, the second column headed "S" are Sterling's num bers. My intention in making this list comparative is to facilitate collectors in re-arranging, who have previously ar ranged their collections according to Sterling's list. It is my wish to give Mr Sterling full credit for all matter used from his catalogue in compiling my list, and also to extend my thanks to him for his courtesy in granting me his full permission.

It has been necessary to make one rad ical change in Mr. Sterling's list, in the case of " $C$ " variety, 1 , which 1 have placed in my list as "H" variety, 1 Upon ample proof and reasoning it has been decided that this type was not printed by the American Phototype Co of New York but by Jos. R. Carpenter of Philadelphia, Pa., thereby necessitating its change from the New York series to the Philadelphia series. I have also omitted the listing of the Tom Thumb or vest pocket size checks from the order in which Mr. Sterling had them listed as "E" variety, 1a, and have made a separate list of them which will be found immediately after the list of stamped paper of the Spanish American war period.
