Mr. Tiffeny was a collector of the oid school, one who collected stamps for the love of them; usually one of a kind only, taking the stamp used or unused as it happened to come, sometimes even taking a slighty defective copy where a good one wat not readily obtained. To give a liat of bis collection would be only to repeat the catalogue as it was in 1890 . Broadly apeaking stamps previous to $187{ }^{\prime}$ or 1880 are used, 1880 to 1891 unused.
