

The paper used in its manufacture is thin and porous, with plenty of strength for all requirements, but in almost every case would peel or tear with less force than would the stamps. This is a good quality, as most of the Hinges now on the market are made of a tough, fibrous paper that in the majority of cases is stronger and will stand more strain than the stamp. Therefore, the greatest care has to be exercised in removing the stamps, as it often requires more strain to tear the hinge or loosen the gum than the stamps will bear, and as a consequence you have stamps sent to the hospital for a patch.



The hinges are carefully put up in tightly bound packages of about 400 each, and packed in boxes of 5000. The box is well made and serves as a handy receptacle for them. APPROVAL TRADE

The system of sending to collectors upon approval stamps mounted upon sheets and in books has been very much abused by both dealers and collectors. We wish to state our rules and regulations in regard to this department of our business very plainly:

ACCOUNTS OPENED BY MINORS MUST BE APPROVED AND GUARANTEED BY PARENTS OR GUARDIAN.

All stamps that we forward by registered mail must also be returned to us registered.

Correspondents are expected to pay return postage, registration and cost of draft or money order.

Coin must not be sent by mail, on account of the danger of loss through breaking the envelope or theft.

Canada silver will not be accepted. Canada currency is 2 per cent discount, and unused Canadian stamps 5 per cent discount.

The most desirable form of remittance is express or post-office money order. Unused United States stamps 3 per cent discount. This form of remittance is undesirable.

We have not the time to devote to petty approval sheet business, and further selections will not be sent to parties whose net remittances are below \$1 00, unless there is a reasonable excuse. The trade of the class of people who are in the habit of requesting sheets to buy a few cents' worth of stamps is respectfully declined.

Selections of stamps should not be kept more than 5 days, and in extreme cases 10 days. Parties who are slow and in the habit of being dunned for returns will not request stamps.

Unless you have an open account or are known to us, good business or bank references are required.

We shall take pleasure in devoting our time and attention to collectors who are buyers of stamps, and are always glad to make new friends.

OUR APPROVAL STOCK

We have classified books for stamps from almost every country in the world. These are arranged to include books of either used or unused stamps only, also mixed (these are books in which no stamp is priced more than 51.00), and others, where the countries are made up as complete as possible, including rarieties and all varieties. Our specialty is the stamps of the American Continent, and therefore the books of these stamps are naturally more complete.
