CONSTITUTION  
OF THE  
**National Philatelic Society.**

**ARTICLE I.—NAME.**

This Association shall be known as the *National Philatelic Society*.

**ARTICLE II.—OBJECTS.**

The objects for which this Society is formed are :  
1.—The encouragement of the Collection and Preservation of Postage Stamps and Revenue Stamps of all nations, as well as those issued by states, corporations and individuals.

2.—The procuring and dissemination of knowledge in relation thereto.

3.—The inculcation of the best principles of classification and arrangement.

4.—The consideration of Stamps in their relations to Geography, History and Chronology, Politics, Language and the Fine Arts.

5.—The exchange of duplicates among members as specified in article IX.

**ARTICLE III.—MEMBERSHIP.**

**Section 1.** The membership of this Society shall be divided into the three following classes :

1. Active members.
2. Corresponding members.
3. Honorary members.

The first class shall constitute the governing body of the society, from which all officers and committees must be chosen.

The second class shall consist of those who, by reason of residence abroad, or distance from the place of meeting, do not desire to become active

members. They are expected to take an interest in the objects of the society, and to aid it by contributions or information.

The third class shall consist of those persons, who, by virtue of valuable service in the cause of Philately, are considered deserving of the distinctive title of honorary members.

**Sec. 2.** Proposals for membership in either of these classes must be made in writing, by an active member of the society, at one of its meetings, and shall be referred to the Executive Committee, who shall report thereon.

**Sec. 3.** No candidate shall be entitled to membership without the consent, by ballot, of three quarters of the members present at a regular meeting, nor shall any candidate be balloted for, upon whom the Executive Committee may have made an adverse report.

**Sec. 4.** Any member in good standing, may become a life member by the payment at any one time of a sum equal to five years' dues.

**ARTICLE IV.—GOVERNMENT.**

**Sec. 1.** The government of the Society shall be vested in the following named officers :

1. President.
2. Vice President.
3. Secretary.
4. Treasurer.
5. Librarian.
6. Executive Committee of three members.

**Sec. 2.** The term of each officer shall be for one year from the date of his election, and until a successor be appointed.

**Sec. 3.** It shall be the duty of the President, and in his absence, that of the Vice President, to preside at all meetings of the society.

In the absence of both President and Vice President, a temporary chairman shall be appointed.

**Sec. 4.** The Secretary shall keep accurate minutes of all transactions and proceedings of the society. He shall conduct all its correspondence, keeping copies thereof in a book provided for that purpose. All letters received by him in his official capacity, shall be filed among the archives of the society.

**Sec. 5.** The Treasurer shall receive and disburse all moneys; provided that no moneys shall be expended by him, except by resolution therefor, duly adopted by the society. He shall keep a strict account, in writing, of all moneys which he may so receive and disburse, and his books of accounts shall at all reasonable times be open to the inspection of the society or any of its members.

**Sec. 6.** The Librarian shall take charge of all books and papers belonging to the society, and shall keep the same in good order.

**Sec. 7.** The Executive Committee shall inquire into the merits of all applicants for membership, and report thereon to the society. It shall also act as a standing committee of reference for any matters that may be duly referred to it by the society.

## CONSTITUTION

of the

### National Philatelic Society

#### Article I.—NAME.

This Association shall be known as the *National Philatelic Society*.

#### Article II.—OBJECTS.

The objects for which this Society is formed are:  
1. The encouragement of the collection and preservation of postage stamps and revenue stamps of all nations, as well as those issued by states, corporations and individuals.  
2. The promotion and dissemination of knowledge in relation thereto.  
3. The application of the best principles of classification and arrangement.  
4. The exhibition of stamps in their relations to Geography, History and Chronology, Pictures, Languages and the Fine Arts.  
5. The exchange of duplicates among members as specified in article IX.

#### Article III.—MEMBERSHIP.

*Section 1.*—The membership of this Society shall be divided into the three following classes:

##### 1. Active members,

##### 2. Corresponding members,

##### 3. Honorary members.

The first class shall constitute the governing body of the society, from which all officers and committee must be chosen.

The second class shall consist of those who, by reason of residence abroad, or distance from the place of meeting, do not desire to become active

members. They are expected to take an interest in the objects of the society, and to aid it by contributions or information.

The third class shall consist of those persons, who, by virtue of valuable service in the cause of Philately, are considered deserving of the distinctive title of honorary members.

*Soc. 8.*—The secretary, treasurer and librarian shall turn over at the termination of their offices all letters, money, wands, documents or other papers belonging to the society to their successors.

#### Article VI.—ELECTIONS.

*Soc. 1.*—The term of each officer shall be for one year from the date of his election, and until a successor be appointed.

*Soc. 2.*—It shall be the duty of the President, and in his absence, that of the Vice President, to preside at all meetings of the society.

*In the absence of both President and Vice President, a temporary chairman shall be appointed.*



a vacancy occurs in any of the offices, the same shall be filled at the next regular meeting.

Sec. 2. The election of officers shall be by ballot, a majority of the whole number of votes cast being necessary for a choice.

#### ARTICLE VII.—SUBSCRIPTIONS.

Sec. 1. The annual subscription shall be four dollars for active members, payable quarterly at the first meetings in January, April, July and October and two dollars for corresponding members.

Sec. 2. Any member, in arrears for over three months' dues, shall be notified of the fact by the Treasurer, and requested to pay the same. If, within thirty days after such notification and request, the arrearage be not paid, he shall then, on motion, cease to be a member of the society, and his name stricken from the roll.

#### ARTICLE VIII.—PUBLICATIONS.

The society may, from time to time as it may determine, issue a bulletin or other publication, containing any matter of interest to collectors.

#### ARTICLE IX.—EXCHANGE OF DUPLICATES.

The Executive Committee shall take charge of any stamps that members may desire to sell. These stamps are to be mounted in passbooks and priced, owners names to be kept private. The Committee shall keep account of these books and turn the proceeds over to their owners after deducting ten per cent. for the treasury of the society. All other selling of stamps during the meetings being prohibited.

#### ARTICLE X.—AMENDMENTS.

This Constitution shall not be altered, modified or amended except at a regular meeting, by a two-thirds vote of the members present. No action thereon shall be valid, unless one month's notice shall have been given.

That no transfer of said stock, or the certificate thereof, shall be valid unless made in writing and signed by the Association, and signed by the member transferring the same, or his lawful attorney, and attested by the Secretary, upon return of the outstanding certificate, which shall be canceled and filed by the Secretary. That the holder is liable for the payment to the Association of the annual dues provided for by the By-Laws, until the said stock and certificate are surrendered to the Association, and is not entitled to vote said stock so long as he is in any manner indebted to the Association. That the Association has a first lien on the said stock and all increments thereof for all indebtedness of the holder to the Association; and that no transfer thereof shall be permitted, so long as the holder is so indebted to the Association; and that the possession of said certificate shall not be regarded as evidence of the ownership of the holder, or his right to participate as a stockholder, unless it appears upon the books of the Association that all said conditions have been duly complied with. That the ownership of said stock shall at all times be subject to the provisions of the By-Laws.
