The most important of all is, one side of the page is only counted to hold the stamps, and if both sides be used, double the quantity of stamps can be inserted. The paper used is a strong but light quality, bright surface, and the ink will not run or blur, as in the case of poor quality of paper. 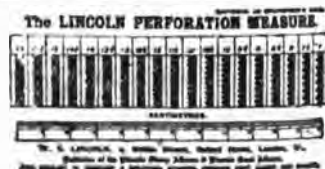

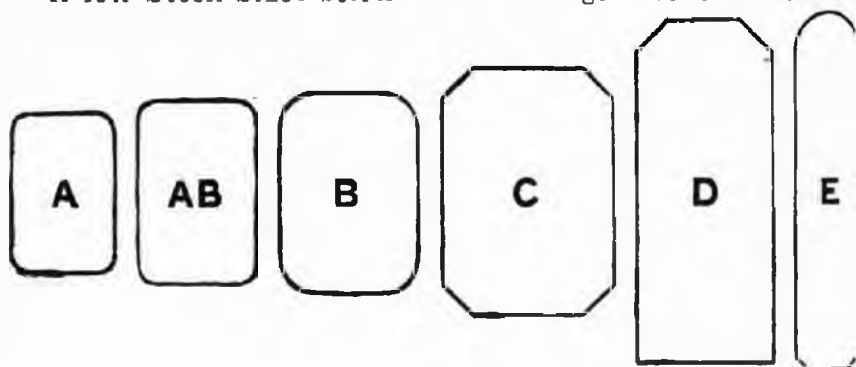
