It will be observed that the present Edition contains important alterations, both in contents and arrangement. The classification of dealers under towns is an entirely new idea, and is intended to enable philatelists when travelling to locate the various dealers in the neighbourhood they happen to be visiting. We are also introducing for the first time a Foreign and Colonial Appendix, which although small at present will no doubt grow as its usefulness becomes appreciated.

In preparing this Edition we sent special Enquiry Forms to the dealers whose names appeared in the last DIRECTORY, and also to about one hundred others. We regret that comparatively few of the Forms were returned to us; but we have endeavoured to assure our position, as compilers, by making a difference in the type used. The names of dealers returning our Enquiry Forms are printed in small capitals; but the names of those who have not returned the Enquiry Forms are printed in ordinary Roman type (similar to the addresses), and it must be clearly understood that we cannot guarantee the correctness of those entries.

Of the names and addresses in the Twelfth Edition about seventy have been taken out; in the majority of cases dealers have "gone away," whilst others have requested the withdrawal of their names, having gone out of the business. Between twenty and thirty corrections have been obtained in addresses, etc., and every possible effort has been made to produce a Directory reflecting the exact state of the British Stamp Trade at the date of closing for press, viz:—October 31st, 1901.

Our grateful thanks are due to the dealers who kindly responded to our request for information, and also to the advertisers—over forty in number—who have favoured us with their announcements. On behalf of these latter we would respectfully solicit a share of our readers' attention and patronage.
