## PREEACE.

The prosent Diditor of "Opprix's Postage Stamp Catanocl hi," on submitting the Tenth Fidition for public approval, begs to say that continued wrivion has corrected some inaccuracies in the descriptions and colours of stamps. Many errors in date have been ameuded, all new issues inserted up to the present time, and a few non-existent specimens discarded.

Little mention is made of essays and none at all of forgeries: so very many of the former, and, we regret to add, of the latter also, are rite, that a partial notice would be incomplete, and a full one exceed our bounds. The valuable work of Berger Levrault, just published, on essays, and that of Pemberton or Stourton on forgeries, should we in the hands of erery postagestamp collector. We have excepted from exile our own essays, from patriotic motives; that of New Brunswick, for its singular history; those of Zarich, as being the first foreign postal emmation; and those of I'araghay, Persia, St. Kitt's, and Guatemala, to reserve a compartment for the possibly ere lung forthcoming regular issues.

In conclusion, the Editor and Publisher hope this amended work will find favour in the eyes of the philatelic public, and trust their cxtendert patronage will soon afford opportunity for the adoption of any ficuall: suggestions towards the improvement of yet another cdition.
