## **Express Delivery of Letters, Parcels, and other Postal Packets.**

---

THE object of the *Post Office Express Service* is to secure the immediate delivery of Messages, Letters, Parcels and other Postal Packets, by Special Messenger. It is applicable not only to Local Packets which may be sent from one part of a town or district to another part direct by Special Messenger, without being forwarded in any Mail Bag, but also to Letters and Parcels sent in the first instance by the ordinary Mails, either from one part of a town to another or from one town or country district to another.

Thus, to give examples:—

- (1.) A Letter may be sent by Special Messenger from the City to Charing Cross, or from Kensington to Hampstead. In such a case the Letter is carried at once to its destination, the time occupied in delivery being merely that taken by the actual journey of the Messenger.
- (2.) Where speed is not of so much importance, a local Letter or Parcel—*i.e.*, one going from one part of the town to another, *e.g.*, in London, from Hammersmith, W., to Cheapside, E.C., or, in Brighton, from Kemp Town to Hove—may be posted for transmission in the ordinary course of post to the office from which delivery is to be made, and on arrival there be sent out by Special Messenger, and delivered from one to two hours earlier than if it were taken out by the Postman.
- (3.) An Express Letter from Manchester to some place in the East Central District of London will be forwarded in the ordinary Mail to London, but will on its arrival at the General Post Office be at once picked out from amongst the other Letters and despatched by Special Messenger to its destination, which it will reach in due course from one to two hours before a Letter arriving by the same Mail and delivered in the ordinary Postman's round. In many cases this will admit of important letters being delivered during business hours in the evening, which would otherwise not receive attention until the following morning.
- (4.) An Express Letter from Grimsby addressed to Billingsgate Market, or one from Liverpool addressed to Smithfield Market, reaching London by the

Night Mails, would be delivered soon after 5.0 a.m., whereas ordinary Letters arriving by the same Mails would not be delivered until about 8.0 a.m. An Express Parcel for Covent Garden Market sent from the West of England by the Night Mail would be delivered at from 5.15 to 6.15 a.m., but an ordinary Parcel would not be delivered until an hour and a quarter later. Express Letters, &c. reaching London by Day Mails are delivered by Special Messenger from one to two hours earlier than if they were taken out by the Postmen in the ordinary way.

- (5.) An Express Letter posted in London, too late for the Night Mail, for a village in the neighbourhood of a country town, where there is only one delivery a day, *e.g.*, for Barford St. Martin, near Salisbury, can on arriving at Salisbury about 7.15 a.m. in the morning be at once delivered in Barford St. Martin by Special Messenger instead of lying at the Salisbury Post Office till the following morning.
- (6.) Where the ordinary Mails do not readily serve, a Letter may be despatched as a Single Post Railway Letter, *e.g.*, from Salisbury to London, by train and delivered from Waterloo Station by Special Messenger immediately on the arrival of the train; or it may be sent from Barford St. Martin to Salisbury Railway Station by Special Messenger, for despatch by train and delivered in the same manner from Waterloo Station, thus securing as rapid a transit as if the sender had despatched his own servant with the Letter from point to point. (*See pages 6 and 7.*)
- (7.) Letters, &c. sent in the ordinary Inland and Foreign Mails which have not been marked for Express Delivery by the senders can be delivered by Special Messenger from the usual office of delivery either occasionally or regularly at the request of the addressee, about half an hour in advance of the ordinary delivery by Postmen. (*See page 9.*)

The following are the detailed regulations of the Service :—

## I.

### LOCAL SERVICE—EXPRESS THROUGHOUT.

Local

Under this Service, Messages, Letters, Parcels, and other Articles are conveyed *the entire distance* by Special Messenger.

*In London* they are accepted at about 250 Post Offices (for names see list at end, pages 12 to 21) for delivery in any part of London and its Suburbs.

*In other parts of the United Kingdom* they are accepted at all Post Offices from which there is a delivery of Telegrams, and are delivered in any part of the Town or Rural District, or in any neighbouring town or village which can be easily reached by Messenger.

The Offices in question are designated Express Delivery Offices.

Articles of a dangerous or offensive character are prohibited.



## SCALE OF CHARGES.

(a.) For a Letter, Packet, or other Article not exceeding 1 lb. in weight the Express Fee is—

For every mile or part of a mile - - - 3d.

For a Letter, Packet, or other Article over 1 lb. in weight the Express Fee is—

For every mile or part of a mile - - - 3d.

For every lb. or part of a lb. beyond the first lb. - 1½d.

The ordinary postage is not charged.

The above fees are inclusive of charges for omnibus, tramcar, railway, or steamboat conveyance.

(b.) If the sender desires that a cab be used, the actual cab fare must be paid by the sender, in addition to the above charges.

(c.) If the distance exceeds two miles, and a public conveyance (*i.e.*, railway, steamboat, omnibus, or tramcar) is not available in both directions, or when a Messenger is required to undertake a long distance Express Service at night which cannot be performed out and in, on foot, or by means of a public conveyance, the actual cab fare must in all cases be paid in addition to the Express fees.

(d.) When several Letters or Packets are tendered for delivery to one person, they should be tied by the sender so as to form one Packet, which will be chargeable with the single Express fee of 3d. a mile; but the total weight carried in each case for a single fee of 3d. a mile must not be more than 1 lb. If it exceeds 1 lb., the ordinary weight-charge of 1½d. per lb. will be made.

No single Packet must exceed 15 lbs. in weight unless a cab is provided at the cost of the sender.

(e.) When several Letters or Packets are tendered by one sender for delivery by the same Messenger at different addresses, or to different persons at the same address, and the sender desires that one Messenger only should be employed, the Express Fee of 3d. a mile will be charged for the full distance to be traversed by the Messenger up to the delivery of the last article, and an additional fixed charge of 2d. for each article above one. The numbers of articles delivered by one Messenger must not exceed 10. The usual weight charge of 1½d. per lb. will be made for each article exceeding 1 lb. in weight, and the aggregate weight of all the articles must not exceed 15 lbs., unless a special conveyance be used.

In calculating the distance charge, the whole mileage traversed up to the delivery of the last article, but not further, will be charged for. The sender may determine the order in which the Packets are to be delivered.

A Messenger engaged in this service may accept any further service from any one of the addressees according to the usual rule (*see below*, "Reply and Further Services"), subject to this condition, that no such service is to be performed until after the delivery of every packet originally entrusted to him.

## EXAMPLES OF CHARGES.

For four Letters or Packets, each not exceeding 1 lb. in weight, conveyed for a distance of between two and three miles :—

(f.) *All charges must be prepaid* in postage stamps to be affixed to a Post Office form provided for the purpose.

## POSTING AND DISTINCTIVE MARKING.

- (a.) Every Packet must be *handed in over the counter*. In no case may it be placed in a letter box.
- (b.) The words "Express Delivery" must be boldly and legibly written by the sender above the address in the left-hand corner of the cover.

## HOURS OF POSTING.

Week days, 8.0 a.m. to 7.0. p.m. In London the hours are, as a rule, from 8.0 a.m. to 7.45 p.m., except at certain important Offices where Packets can be accepted up to the later hours shown in the list at the end of this notice.

There is no Express Delivery on Sunday, Good Friday,\* or Christmas Day.

## REPLY AND FURTHER SERVICES.

On the delivery of an Express Packet the delivering Messenger may take a reply or perform a further Express Delivery service within the authorised hours. The fee must be prepaid either by the sender of the first service or by the sender of the reply or further service.

When a reply or further service is required by the sender, the words "Wait Reply" or "Further Service" should be written by the sender above the address of the Packet. The Messenger is allowed to wait for the reply 10 minutes free of charge, but after

that time *2d.* is charged for every quarter of an hour or part of a quarter of an hour during which the Messenger is required to wait.

The fee for a Reply or Further Service is at the same rate as for the original service, viz., *3d.* a mile, but when a Packet on a reply or further service is taken to an address on the Messenger's homeward route, or to an address within a radius of half a mile of the Post Office from which the Messenger started on the original service, half only of the mileage rate is charged. If the Packet exceeds 1 lb. in weight, the full weight-charge due thereon is imposed.

If more than one Letter or Packet be sent on a Reply or Further Service (*see above*, page 3, Scale of Charges—par. (e.)), and the charges are prepaid by the sender of the original service, an additional fixed charge of *2d.* will be made for each article beyond one in accordance with the regulation in par. (e) above. The usual weight-charge of  $1\frac{1}{2}d.$  per lb. will also be levied upon each article exceeding 1 lb. in weight.

#### ACCEPTANCE OF EXPRESS PACKET BY TELEGRAPH MESSENGER.

A Telegraph Messenger, on delivering a telegram, may, if desired, take back to the Post Office where he is employed a Postal Packet for Express Delivery. The Charges should be prepaid by the sender. The Express Fee for such Service will be charged as from the residence of the sender, and not from the Office where the Messenger is employed.

#### LATE FEE LETTERS TO BE POSTED AT RAILWAY STATIONS.

*Letters to be posted in the Late Fee Letter Boxes attached to the Mail Trains* starting from the London Railway Termini (*see Post Office Guide*, pages 302 and 302A) are accepted at any Express Delivery Post Office in London for immediate conveyance to the Railway Stations by Special Messenger at the above rates of charge. The Postage and Late Fee must be prepaid in stamps affixed to the Letter, but the charge for the Express Service must be prepaid in stamps affixed to a Post Office Form.

#### POSTING OF LATE LETTERS AND PARCELS.

*Letters and Parcels* are accepted at any Express Delivery Post Office for conveyance by Special Messenger to the General Post Office, or other Post Office in London, or to the Chief Offices in Provincial Towns, for an outgoing Mail on payment of the Express Fee. The Postage and Late Fee (if any be chargeable) must be prepaid in stamps affixed to the Letter or Parcel, but the charge for the Express Service must be prepaid in stamps affixed to a Post Office Form.

#### MESSENGERS CALLED BY TELEPHONE OR PRIVATE WIRE.

Subscribers to the Telephone Exchanges of the Post Office, and Renters of private wires terminating at a Post Office, can use their wires without extra charge for the purpose of summoning a Messenger for the Express Delivery of Postal Packets, &c. The fees for such Express Service are charged to deposit account, and are calculated on the whole distance traversed by the Messenger from the Post Office from which he is summoned to the place of call, and thence to the place of delivery.



## SINGLE LETTERS TO BE CONVEYED BY RAILWAY.

*Railway Letters* (i.e., single Inland Post Letters not exceeding 1 oz. in weight accepted by a Railway Company under an agreement with the Postmaster-General for conveyance by the next available train or steamship—see page 35, Post Office Guide), may be handed in at any Post Office at which the Express Service is in operation for immediate conveyance to the Railway Stations by Special Messenger on payment of the Express Fee of 3*d.* a mile in stamps affixed to a Post Office Form.

Such Letters, after transmission by train, can, on reaching the Office of Delivery in the ordinary course of post, be sent at once to their destination by Special Messenger, or, if desired, they can be delivered by Special Messenger either from the first Express Office which they reach, or direct from the Station. In the latter case the Sender must telegraph to the Postmaster of the nearest Postal Telegraph Office to the Station of Arrival requesting him to send a Special Messenger to meet the Train, and deliver the Letter. The Letter must, in all cases, be marked "Express Delivery," and with a perpendicular line both on front and back. If it is to be delivered from the first Express Office which it reaches after being collected from the Posting Box at the Station, it must be marked "Express Delivery from first Express Office," and if direct from the station with the words "To be handed to Post Office Express Messenger at \_\_\_\_\_ Station." If the Messenger has to wait at the Station more than 10 minutes owing to late arrival of the train, the usual charge for waiting, viz., 2*d.* for each quarter of an hour or portion thereof beyond the first 10 minutes, will be collected from the addressee, as in the case of a Reply or Further Service, see page 4. The Postage, the Express Fee, and any charge for Special Conveyance must be prepaid on the letter in stamps by the sender. In London the Post Offices nearest to the principal termini are as follows:—

## EXPRESS AFTER FIRST STAGE.

Express Letters and Packets, &c., may be handed in at any Post Office which is not an Express Delivery Office, under the following conditions:—

The Packet, which must be of such a nature that it can be sent by the ordinary Inland Post, takes the ordinary course of post from the Office where it is handed in, until it reaches the first Express Delivery Office on its route, and is thence conveyed direct to destination by Express Messenger.

The Express fees are charged as from the Express Delivery Office and not from the Office of Posting, and *must be prepaid* by the sender.

It must be clearly understood that in such cases there will be some delay before the Packet reaches the hands of an Express Messenger, so that where an Express Delivery Office is within easy reach the sender is recommended to take his Packet to that Office.

## II.

EXPRESS DELIVERY AFTER TRANSMISSION BY  
ORDINARY MAIL.

Under this Service Letters and Parcels are forwarded by Mail in the regular course of Post, and on arrival at the Office of Delivery are sent out by Special Messenger.

## FEES.

1.—(a.) *In addition to the full ordinary postage* the Express Fee is:—

For every mile or part of a mile from the Office of Delivery - 3d.  
(The weight charge of 1½d. a lb. does not apply in this case.)

(b.) If the sender desires that a *special conveyance* be used, or if the distance exceeds two miles, and a public conveyance is not available in both directions, the actual cost of a special conveyance (generally 1s. a mile) must be paid in addition to the Express fee and postage.

(c.) The sender is responsible for the fee and charges. The fee is in no case less than 3d., and, together with *the postage, should be prepaid* by means of stamps affixed to the Letter or Parcel. In any case where a special conveyance is required, the whole charge for such conveyance should, if possible, be prepaid in postage stamps affixed to the Letter or Parcel, but any deficiency will be demanded from the addressee. If at least one-half of the Express fee and charge for special conveyance *is not prepaid*, the Post Office does not undertake to deliver the Letter or Parcel by Special Messenger, but it will be liable to be treated as an ordinary Letter or Parcel.

In London the fee in addition to the ordinary postage does not exceed 3d. in cases where the Letter or Parcel is to be "expressed" from the usual Delivering Office. If, however, the article is required to be



“expressed” from the General Post Office, or from one of the Chief District Offices to an address outside the ordinary delivery of such Offices, the Express fee will in most cases exceed 3*d.* according to the distance.

- (*d.*) When more than one Express Letter or Parcel addressed to the same person is received by the same Mail or by Mails arriving at or about the same time, and the Express Fees payable thereon are unpaid or not fully prepaid, such articles will be sent out for delivery by the same special Messenger; one full Express Fee of 3*d.* a mile being charged upon one of the articles, and a fixed charge of 1*d.* upon each of the rest. In calculating such charges the value of any postage stamps affixed to the articles beyond the ordinary postage will, of course, be allowed for.

#### POSTING AND DISTINCTIVE MARKING.

- 2.—(*a.*) The words “EXPRESS DELIVERY” must be boldly and legibly marked above the address on the left-hand side of the cover (whether of Letter or Parcel), and in the case of a Letter the cover must in addition be marked with a *broad perpendicular line from top to bottom both on front and back.*
- (*b.*) *Letters* may be handed in at a Post Office, or to a Rural Postman, or, if not for registration, may be posted in a letter box.
- (*c.*) *Parcels and Registered Letters* for this Service must be handed in at a Post Office, or to a Rural Postman.

N.B.—The Post Office does not undertake to ensure the delivery by Special Messenger of an Express Mail Letter which is not marked in the manner prescribed.

#### DELIVERY.

##### *On Week Days.*

- 3.—(*a.*) By Messenger, during the hours in which the Office of Delivery is open for Telegraph business.
- (*b.*) To Callers, whether by day or by night, when the Postal Staff is in attendance, if the Letter or Parcel arrive too early or too late for delivery by Special Messenger, or if it be addressed to the Post Office “To be called for.”

##### *On Sundays.*

#### LETTERS ONLY.

- (*c.*) By Messenger, during the hours when the Office of Delivery is open for Telegraph business, and to callers for letters.

N.B.—In London there is no Express Delivery of Mail Letters on Sunday.

#### PARCELS.

- (*d.*) There is no delivery on Sunday.

REPLY AND FURTHER SERVICE.

On the delivery of a Letter or Parcel the Messenger may, if desired, take from the Addressee a Letter or Parcel for Express Delivery under any of the Services described in this Notice.

---

SPECIAL DELIVERY FROM CHIEF OFFICES.

Letters and Parcels transmitted by Mail in the ordinary course of Post from any Provincial Office to London can be delivered by Special Messenger from the General Post Office or other Chief District Office at which the bag containing the Letter or Parcel is first opened, thus gaining considerably in time of delivery. Similarly, Letters and Parcels addressed to any part of the Town or Rural District served from a Provincial Head Post Office, can, if desired, be sent out for delivery by Special Messenger from the Head Office.

Express Delivery of Mail Letters from Chief or Head Office instead of from subordinate Office.

FEE.

The Express Delivery fee is chargeable subject to the same conditions as in the foregoing Service, and is calculated according to the distance of the address from the Office from which delivery is actually made. In no case must a fee of less than 3d. be prepaid in addition to the Postage, and if the distance be over two miles, or a special conveyance is required, one half of the amount chargeable must be prepaid in stamps affixed to the Letter or Parcel.

DISTINCTIVE MARKING.

The words "EXPRESS DELIVERY FROM CHIEF OFFICE" must be boldly and legibly marked above the address on the left-hand side of the cover of the Letter or Parcel, and the Letter must in addition be marked with a broad perpendicular line from top to bottom both on the front and back.

If the Letter or Parcel is intended to be delivered by Express Messenger from the General Post Office, or a Chief District Office in London, it should be marked "Express delivery from General Post Office" or "Express delivery from Head District Office," as the case may be.

SPECIAL DELIVERY OF LETTERS, &c. IN ADVANCE OF THE ORDINARY DELIVERIES BY POSTMEN AT THE REQUEST OF THE ADDRESSEE.

Persons or firms who desire at any time to receive their Letters or other Postal Packets of any kind (including Parcels, Book and Sample Packets, Newspapers, and Circulars) in advance of the ordinary delivery, may have them delivered by special Messenger on payment of the following fees, viz. :—

Express Delivery at request of Addressee.

The full Express fee of 3d. a mile as for one Packet, and 1d. for every 10, or less number, of additional packets beyond the first.

Applications for such special delivery must be signed by the person to whom or firm to which the Letters or Postal Packets in question are addressed. Forms of application may be obtained at any Post Office.

The application should be addressed to the Postmaster or Chief Officer on duty at the Post Office from which the Letters are ordinarily delivered. (For List of Offices from which Letters, &c. are delivered in London by Postmen, *see* pages 12 to 21.) Where possible it should be delivered at the Office by hand; but where this cannot be done it may be handed in at any Post Office or posted in any Letter Box in the District served from the Office. In the latter case the postage should be prepaid by means of a 1d. stamp affixed to the outside of the form. Care should be taken, however, that the application reaches the Office on the previous evening, if it is intended to apply to the early delivery in the morning, and, if to other deliveries during the day, an hour at least before the time at which the delivery by Postmen commences.

The Express fee on at least one Packet must be prepaid in stamps affixed to the application. All additional fees must be paid to the special Messenger on delivery.

If no Letters, &c. for the address given are found, a special Messenger will be sent to inform the applicant to that effect, and the Express fee will be retained to pay for this service.

In cases where a regular delivery by special Messenger is required, either on one or more days of the week, or of Letters, &c. arriving by particular Inland or Foreign Mails, it will be sufficient if only one Form of Application, altered to meet the requirements, is filled up and left with the Postmaster. In such cases the whole of the charges will be collected on the delivery of the Letters. If desired, however, a deposit may be made with the Postmaster to cover the charges for a given period in advance.

### INTERNATIONAL EXPRESS SERVICE.

Arrangements have been made for the delivery by Special Messenger of Letters, &c. marked "Express" despatched from this country to the under-mentioned Foreign Countries, and also for the delivery in London and the United Kingdom generally by Special Messenger of Express Letters, &c. received from those countries, viz. :—

The Letters, &c. intended for Express delivery in any of these Countries should be marked "Express," and be prepaid 3*d.* in addition to the postage. When the addressee resides in the immediate neighbourhood of a Post Office no charge will be made on delivery, but when the place of address is beyond the limits of the ordinary Postal delivery an additional charge will be levied in the country of destination at its Inland Express rate, allowance being made for the 3*d.* prepaid here by the Sender.

Letters, &c. from these Countries marked for Express delivery and prepaid an Express fee in addition to the postage, will be delivered by Express Messenger from the usual delivery office in London, or within a distance of one mile from the local Post Office in the provinces without further charge, but if Express delivery is required to be made from the General Post Office or from the Head District Office in London at an address outside the ordinary delivery of such Office, or beyond a distance of one mile from the local Post Office in the provinces, the charge will be at the same rate as for Inland Express Letters, viz., 3*d.* a mile, and will be collected from the addressee, but in consideration of the fee prepaid by the Sender, 3*d.* will be deducted from the charge for the full distance.

*Letters, &c. (not Parcels) marked for Express delivery and received from any other Countries than those mentioned above, are delivered by Special Messenger and the Charges due for the Express Service are collected on delivery.*

---

## GENERAL REGULATIONS.

Except where otherwise specified, the Express Delivery Services are subject to the existing Regulations governing the Inland Post.

Compensation, according to the published scales, is paid for loss or damage of Express Registered Letters and Express Registered Parcels, and up to 2*l.*, for loss or damage of Express Unregistered Parcels. Express Single Post Railway Letters cannot be registered.

N.B.—*The regulations of the Express Delivery Service will also be found at pages 16b and 227 of the Post Office Guide, and page 57 of the Post Office Handbook.*

List of the Post Offices in each District of London at which Letters and Parcels are accepted—under Service I.—Local Express throughout, *see* pages 2–7 for immediate despatch by special messenger direct to any part of London and its Suburbs, and of the Postmen's Offices in London from which Express Mail Letters and Parcels are delivered under Service II. (Express Delivery after transmission by ordinary mail, *see* pages 7–10) and from which ordinary Letters and Parcels, &c., are sent out by Special Messenger at the request of the addressee, under the regulations shown on page 9.
