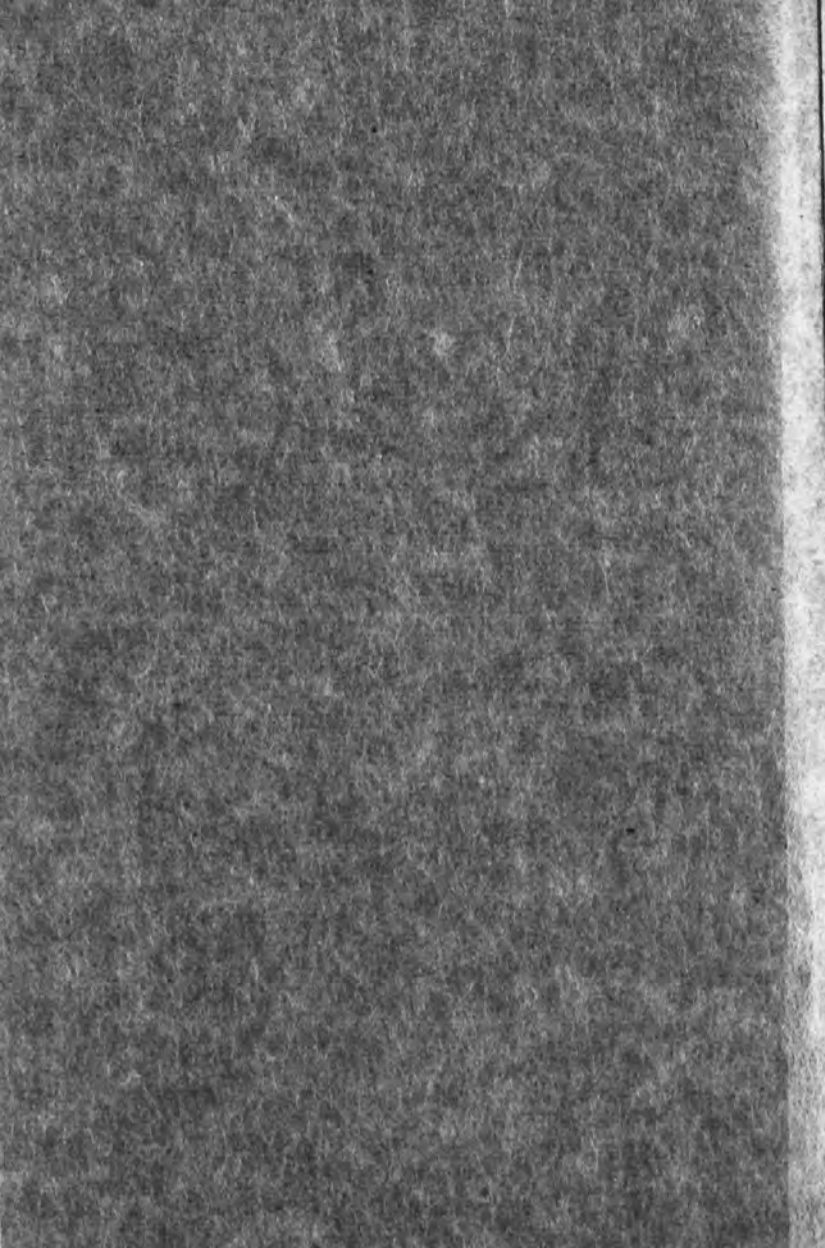

Those rare old departments—those fine old Confederates—

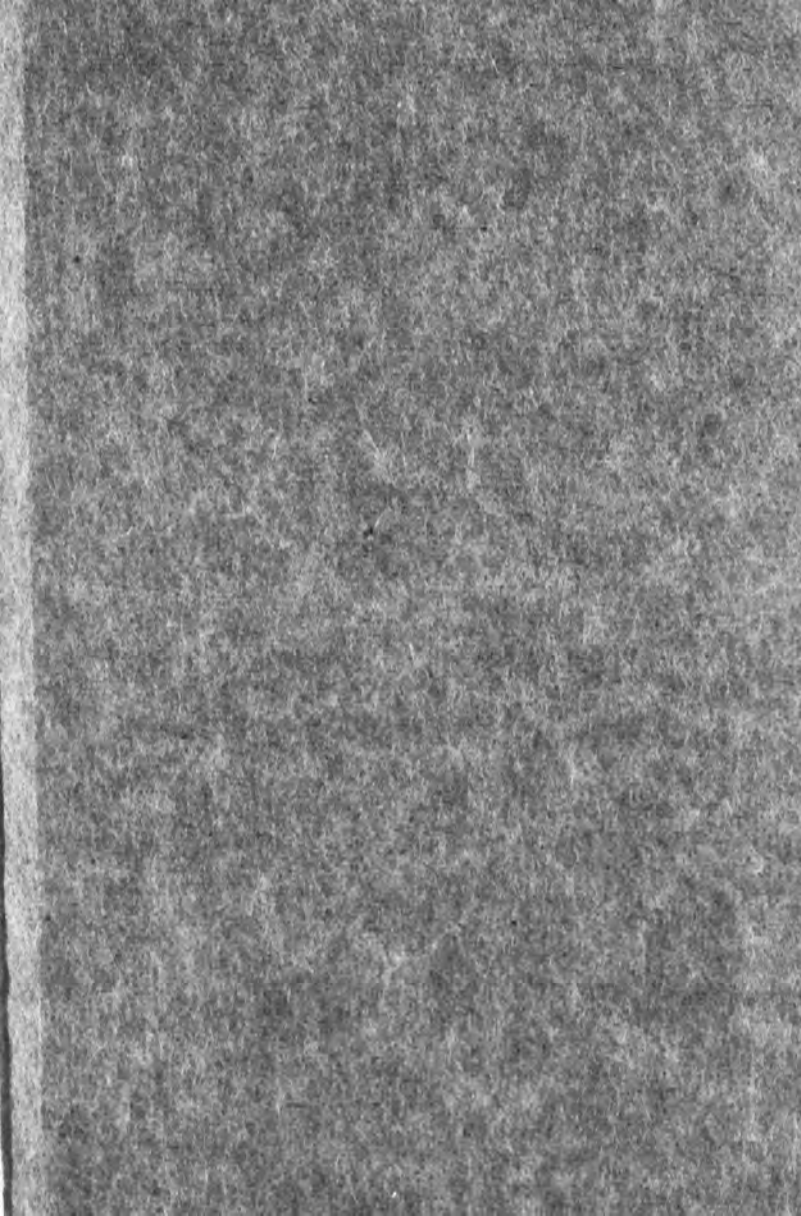
And lots of the stamps the dealers still sell.
