ALABAMA.— Has issued a Nine Anna stamp. It's color is blue.

ANGOLA.— It's set of stamps has been increased by the following stamps viz:— 40 reis, color is blue, 240 reis color is orange, and 300 reis, color is brown.

ARGENTINE REPUBLIC.— The five centavos Stamp has been seen surcharged with a large figure $1\frac{1}{2}$ in. high and 3-16 of an inch wide. A new set of stamps are expected, the colors and values are reported as follows, viz:— 2 centavos color is green, 8 centavos carmine, 16 centavos, green, 24 centavos, blue, 25 centavos, lake.

CANADA:— The international Postal card to be us-

ed between Canada and Great Britain has appeared. The design is similar to the Int. Postal Card now in use. It's value is 2 cts. and it's color is green on a light buff card. The inscription the upper portion reads as follows, "Canada Post Card to United Kingdom, the address only to be written on this side.

CAPE OF GOOD HOPE. The green shilling is now seen surcharged "one penny;" above and has a large band over the old value.

CAPE VERDE ISLAND: issued an entire new set, with values and colors as follows:— 5 reis, black, 10 reis, yellow, 20 reis, bistre, 25 reis, pink, 40 reis, blue, 50 reis, green, 100 reis lilac, 200 reis, orange, 300 reis, brown.

PORTO RICO.— Five new Stamps with designs similar to the recently issued Cuban Stamps have been obtained for this Island Their colors and values are as follows:— 5 cts. green, 10 cts. rose, 15 cts. blue green, 25 cts. ultramarine, 50 cts. bistre.

URUGUAY.— Has emitted the following new Stamps.— 1 cent, brown, 5 cts. green, 10 cts. red brown, 20 cts. ochre, 50 cts. black.
