If just as convenient, please send bids on separate slip of paper. Under 50c may be remitted in 1c stamps; over that, send Express or P.O. money order. Express preferred.

All papers listed in this catalogue are in the finest condition. *None torn, marked, written on or "Sample Copies"* (unless some that cannot be got in any other way).

Small lots are sent in large envelopes, large lots wrapped securely in heavy paper. 3c, 6c, 8c and 15c stamps used.
