Two hundred sets of the 1860 issue of Nova Scotia have turned up, and the entire lot has been sold to a Canadian syndicate.

The Geneva exhibition has been a great success. The stamps were shown and the local committees made everything pleasant for visitors.

Stanley Gibbons exhibited his Trinidad St Vincent collection valued at \$25000.

The Nova Scotia find did not create any flurry here, but in England a sensation was developed.

The leading dealers are involved but no definite information is given. It seems that one dealer offered sets at 62c and a few weeks later, another dealer, who claimed to be sole agent fixed price at \$6.

In the absence of a true statement as to the value of the stamps, collectors refuse to buy, except at low prices.
