DIRECTIONS FOR BLOWING EGGS &c. With a fine needle *drill* holes in each end, then put your mouth to the large end and expel the contents by blowing gently. This can only be done when the egg is fresh. Small eggs can be tried by putting them into a vessel of water, if they swim they are bad, but if they sink they are fit for blowing. When blown they should be placed in wool. To be sent by post they can be packed with wool in tin or pasteboard boxes, care being taken that there is at least half an inch of wool between the eggs themselves and the box, and that the latter is strong enough to stand the *careful* (?) handling of the P. O. clerks.
