- G 1830 - F - H 151 - K FART GVB 15 GR Some stamps are doubly interesting not e only because of their peculiar color, shape or design, but on account of anecdotes that have figured in their excistence. First and foremost among these is the "CONNELL STAMP" of New Brunswick.

Connell was the name of a man who was Post Master General of the colony; he designed a set of stamp, with the purpose of have some prominent member of the royal family on each one.

He placed Queen Victoria and her son on the ten and seventeen cent values respectively, and as he evidently thought the other menbers were not prominent enough, he placed his own portrait on the five cent value. This created quite a sensation and was strenously objected to in England, and as a result it was rejected. It is now a very favorite stamp.
