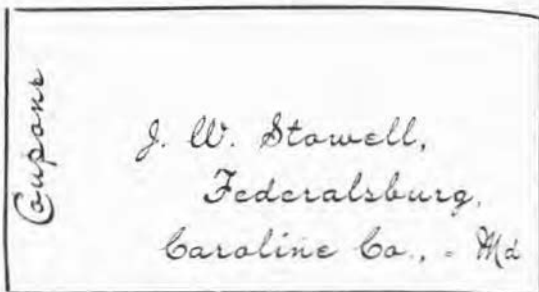

Name the library wanted when sending
the coupons.

Use the coupons out on back of cover and save until

you have three coupons, No.'s 1, 2 and 3. Enclose them in an envelope with the name of the library which the book or books are wanted, and address letter as follows:



Be sure to write the word Coupons across the end of the envelope, so we will know that they contain coupons without opening them. We will wait 15 days after sending out the issue that contains the last coupon (No. 3), so that the subscribers will have plenty of time to send in their coupons. None of the letters received with the word Coupons across the end will be opened. When the 15 days are up, the letters will be placed in a box and put on and shaken. Then some party, blind-folded and in the presence of witnesses, will draw an envelope which will be opened, and the subscriber sending in coupons in said envelope will be awarded the book.
