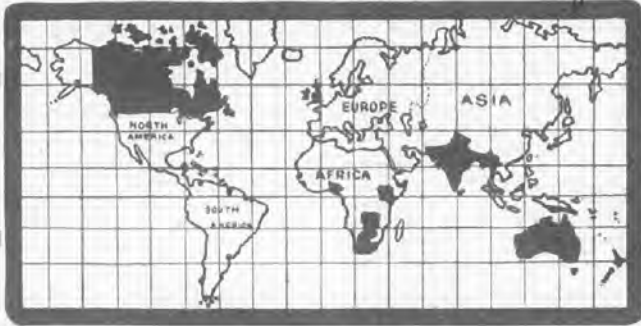

### New Gibbon's Catalogue.

This New Part 1 is a decided advance in many ways on their previous published Catalogues, and as so many Collectors make use of Gibbon's as their guide and authority we are pleased to see so many additions which make stamp collecting more interesting than ever; we are referring mostly to the British Section with Used Abroad stamps, Control Stamps, War Stamps and many other varieties hitherto uncatalogued.

With the "Used Abroad" we get a very wide range of information and prices, the latter showing how much more value is attached to a stamp when used abroad in comparison with ordinary home used stamps.

With regard to the "War Stamps" of *South Africa* we think there is a lot of information still lacking, and without any real definiteness of prices it leaves one too much in the dark; e.g. why are not the different Stations at which Field Force Post Offices existed quoted, for some must be rarer and of more interest than others, again there are the different Towns Post Offices such as Harrismith, etc.

Then the various *Countries* stamps of Cape, Natal, Transvaal O.F.S. with their various face values, also Embossed Envelopes along with "Passed Press Censor" stamped on in various shapes and colours by rubber stamps all of which come under this category.

### Railway Letter Fee Stamps.

All these were passed by the Post Office Authorities for use in conveying letters by Train, on all the different Railways and should

therefore come under the head of British Stamps, the later Earl Crawford was very keen on these, having a wonderful collection of same, and maintained no British collection was complete without them.

### New Issues and Notes.

GREAT BRITAIN—New Control Numbers—1d. Scarlet "D 14" perf. and imperf. margins.

1½d. brown "D 14" perf. and imperf. margins.

2d. orange "D 14" perf. and imperf. margins.

2½d. blue "E 14" perf. and imperf. margins.

8d. black on yellow "D 14" imperf. margin.

AUSTRALIA—of the New Issue the 2nd. (Swan) die is cut (by Harrison) the 6d. is ready, and the 1/- is now being cut. All three values will be printed from steel plates.

The King's Head will be on the ½d., 1d., 2½d., 3d., 4d., and 5d. values and printed by the Government Printer in the ordinary letterpress method, the 2d. will be dark blue, 2½d. light blue, & 5d. light seenna.

We understand that all issues prior to the Kangaroo Series have been recalled from circulation.

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE—

The King George British Stamps overprinted "Bechuanaland Protectorate" ½d. to 5/- have now been supplied and it is expected that the stock of Queen Victoria issues will be withdrawn.

BRITISH GUIANA—48c. grey and black "King George."

CAYMAN ISLANDS—The 2½d. and 5/- values King George design have now been supplied.

EAST AFRICA AND UGANDA—25c. red and black on yellow "King George."

FIJI—The 2d., 2½d., 3d., 4d., 5d., and 1/- King George have now come into issue.

GWALIOR—Official Stamps. The Indian Georgian type overprinted in two lines—

—4 annas olive

8 " mauve

CHAMBA—Official Stamps—

2 annas mauve

4 " olive

"Service—Chamba State" in small thin sans, and

2 annas mauve

"Chamba State" in small thin sans, "Service" in thick sans.

NIGERIA—The new series of this Colony ½d. to £1 King George are now in use.

### Is Stamp Collecting a Sound Investment?

### From Our U.S. Correspondent.

In looking over some of the new penny English stamps, recently the writer came across a stamp which was decidedly orange red. The nearest color to it is the 2c. issue of 1898-99. By comparing the two in the sunlight on a detector he found that the English stamp had quite a noticeable amount more of orange in it. Otherwise the stamp is identical to the new type.

Can any of our readers inform us whether there has been a change in the pigments used in printing the current stamps?

PANAMA contemplates issuing a series of eight stamps to commemorate the Panama Pacific Exhibition at San Francisco, as follows, ¼c. yellow green, Falls of Chorrera; 1c. green, map of Panama Canal; 2c. red, Balboa taking possession of the Pacific Ocean; 2½c. rose, ruins of the Tower and Cathedral of St. Anatosie in the Old City of Panama; 3c. violet, Palace of Arts in the Panama Pacific Exhibition; 5c. blue, Gatun Locks; 10c. vermilion, Culebra Cut; 20c. brown, Ruins of the Monastery of St. Dominique.

The Stamps will be engraved and printed by the American Bank Note Company of New York.

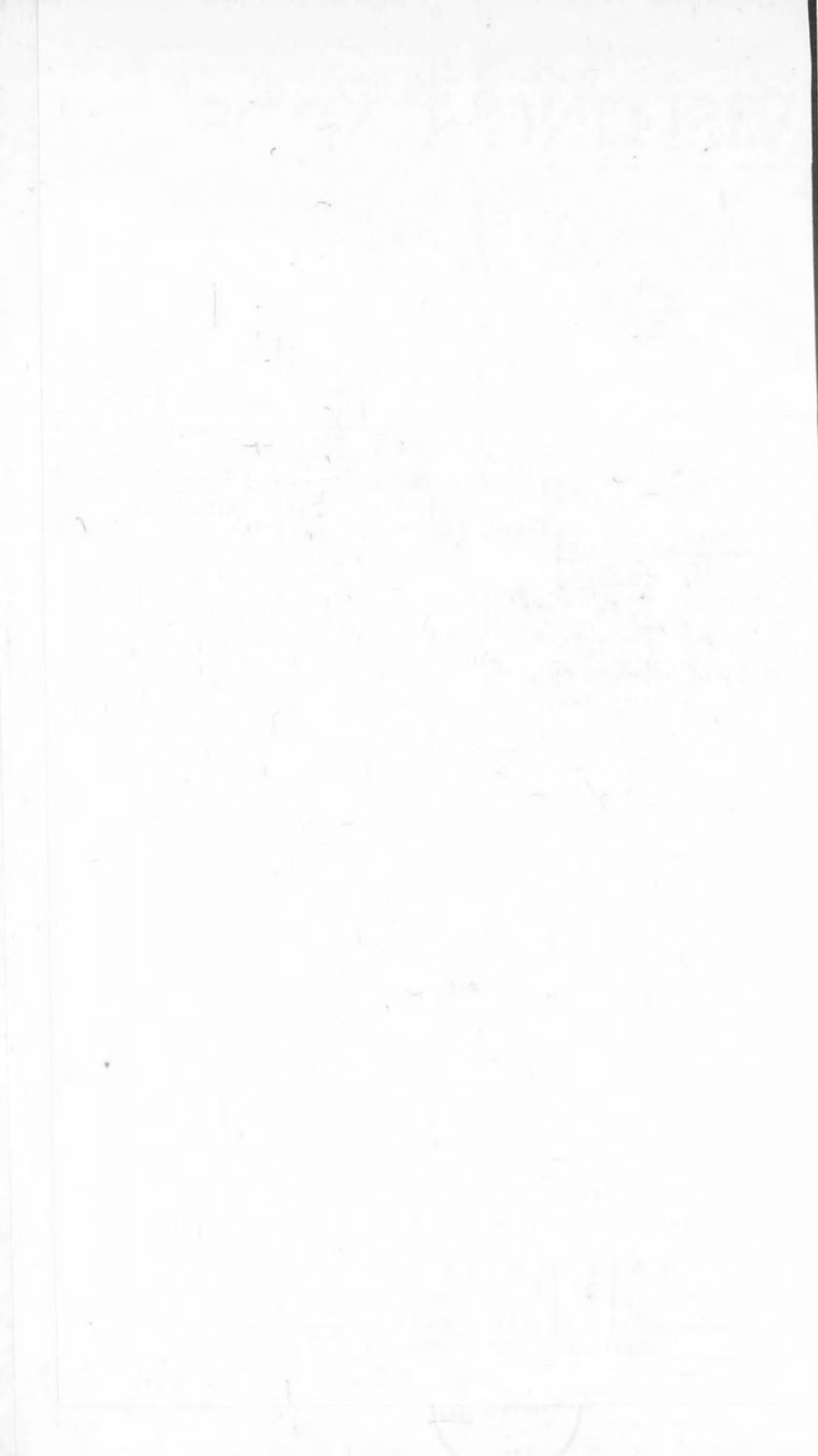
