## United States.

Under this head we take the following from the American Journal of Philately, which will perhaps open the eyes of the people who pay taxes :-
"After a few huadred sheets of the 15 and 24 cent stamps, of the 1869 issue, had been dellivered, it was discovered that a few of the stamps on each sheet had the picture inverted in the frames. The government refused to receive them, and only half sheets of these valnes were issued. This mistake would hare compelled the company to prepare new plates for these values, and of course they would not have paid for them, so they adopted the bright dodge of setting the papers to run down the new issue, so wat they would be required to get new plates by the department, which they would be paid for.
"We all know how well they succeeded. However, to philatelists, this makes two interesting varieties, which are very scarce."

## The New Envelopes.

Having been requested by some to give a list of the new Stamped Envelopes, we insert a full description of the ten values. The design of the stamps consists of different profles, in oval frames, inscribed "U.S. Postage" above, value below, the values in numerals at sides. The values, colors, profles, \&c.,' are as follows :

1 cent, blue, Franklin, numerals at sides in ovals. 2 cents, brown, Jackson, numerals at sides in circle. 3 cents, green, Washington, numerals at sides in circle. 6 cents, carmine, Lincoln, numerals at sides in ovals. 10 cents, brown, Jefferson, numerals at sides in ovals. 12 cents, purple, Clay, numerals at sides in circle.
15 cents, orange, Webster, numerals at sides in transverse ovals.
24 cents, purple, Scott, numerals at sides in shields. 30 cents, black, Hamilton, numerals at sides in octagons. 90 cents, carmine, Perry, numerals at sides in shields.

The above stamps are printed on 25 different envelopes.

## Newly Issued Stamps.

Switzerland, following the example of Austria, has issued a post card, having the 5 c . envelope stamp in the upper left hand corner. It is poorly executed and printed in red.

New Founidland. Two new stamps have appeared for this country, similar in design to the bill stamps of Canada. The colors and valuęs are 3 cents, red; 6 cents, crimson.
Paraguay. At last we have a genuine issue for this country. They consist of a frame with lion and liberty cap in centre, " Republica del Paraguay" above, value below, and in corners. They are printed on thin, white paper, and unperforated. The colors and values are, 1 real, red; 2 reals, blue; 3 reals, black.

New Grenada has issued a 5 pesos stamp, similar in design to the 10 pesos which lately appeared. It is printed in black, on green, glazed paper.

Span. From the Stamp Collector's Magazine wé learn that a new issue will appear the 1st of January.

Roumania has issued a stamp for periodicals. It is printed in black, on green paper.

## List of Postage Stamps issued in 1870.

Alsace and Lorraine, "Postes" above, figure in centre, 1 centime, green; 2 c., brown; 4 c., gray; 10 c. , bistre.

Azores, same as Portugal, surcharged, 240 rels mauve.

Belgium, figure in centre, 1 centime, green; 2 c., blue; 5 c., amber; 8 c., lilac, head to left; 10 c ., green ; 20 c . blue; 30 c . amber; 40 c . rose; 1 franc, violet.

Canada, same device as 1868; 1 cent, orange; 3 c. rose.

Ceylon, head of Victoria, 1 c., mauve.
Deccan, obl., $\frac{3}{}$ anna, olive green.
Denmark, violet centre, brown frame, 48 skillings.

Dutch Indies, "Ned Inde" at top, head to right, 5 c., green; 10 c ., bistre; 20 c., blue; 50 c., carmine.

Egypt, pyramids, 10 paras; oblong, bright mauve.

France, laureated head, 1 centime, green; 30 c., brown disc of lines.

Great Britain, head of Victoria, hd., lake, (small, oblong;) 3 half pence, lake; Post card, dd., violet; newspaper wrapper, d., green.

Italy, obl., red figure, in frame of yellow 1, 2, $5,30,40,60$ centimes; brown tigure in frame of blue, 1 lira, 21.

Mauritius, head of Victoria, I s., blue.
Maderia, same as Portugal, surcharged, 240 reis mauve.

New Foundland, 3 c., red; 6 c., crimson.
Natal, 1860, issue surcharged with "Postage."
New Grenada, rect., unperforated, eagle and shield, in oval, 25 c., black on blue paper; 50 c ., green on white; 1 peso, rose; 10 pesos, large size on glazed paper; 5 c., buff; 5 peso, large, on green, glazed paper.

North German Confederation, Official, oblong, black fig., in stone border, $\frac{4}{4}, \frac{1}{2}, \frac{1}{2}, 1,2$ silber groschen; in border of slate, 1, 2, 3, 7 kreuzer.

Paraguay, rect., unperforated, lion and liberty cap, in centre, 1 real, rose; 2 r., blue; 3 r., black.

Peru, square, unperforated, embossed; 5 c., red.

Portugal, head to left; 100 reis, violet; 240 r., mauve.

Prince Edward Island, head of Victoria; 4hd, brown.

Roumania, rect., unperforated, head Charles I.; . 3 bani, mauve. Periodical stamp, black os green.

Russia, envelope circular; 5 kopecs, rose.
St. Christopher, head of Victoria in circle; 1d, rose; 6d, green.

St. Domingo, rect. arms, U. N., real on blue paper.

St. Vincent; 4d, orange.

South African Republic, rect., unperforated; 3d, manve ; perforated, 1d, red, black; 3d, blue, rose; 6d, mauve; 18, green.
